Another Dorian tune: Wondrous Love. This is a shape not song, from "Southern Harmony"; again going mostly between Am and G with an occasional D. This can be a powerful tune.

The hymn version is often sung at Easter. (first verse below) For accompaniment, you can play a "modal" rhythm all the way through on A-E, produced by holding down the Am and A or A7 bars simultaneously. I did this the last time through at: http://autoharps.home.comcast.net/WondrousLoveGDorian.mp3
