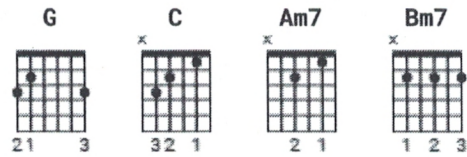


A Pirate Looks At Forty chords by Jimmy Buffett

Tuning: E A D G B E

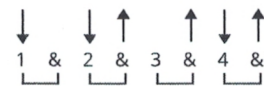
