

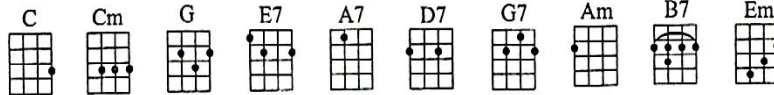

you're gon - na wake up... you will find - you were blind, -



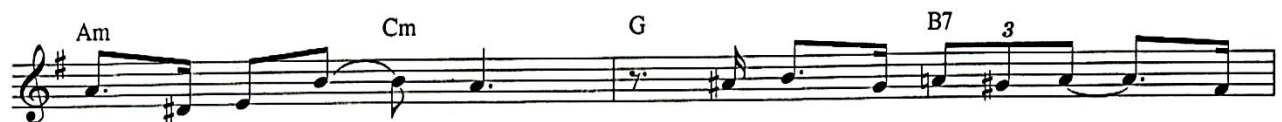

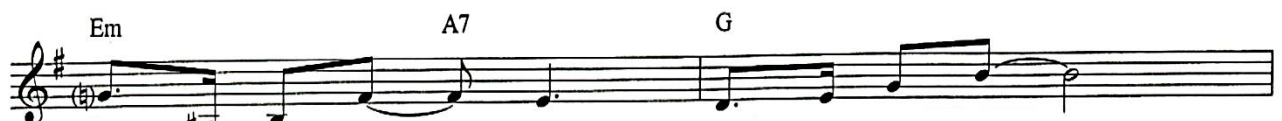
