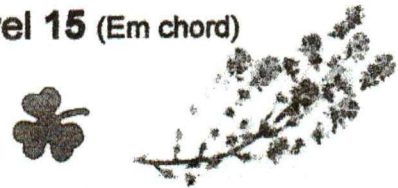


Wild Mountain Thyme

Wild Mountain Thyme for ukulele Key: C Level 15 (Em chord)

(Will Ye Go, Lassie, Go?)

The Corries version (capo 3rd fret for their key= Eb)

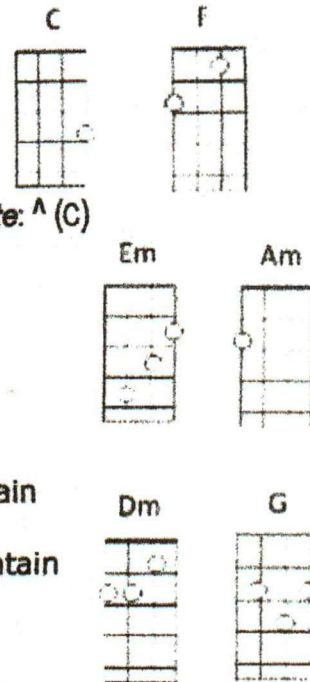


* *C F C F C*
V.1: O the summer time has come, And the trees are sweetly bloomin'
F Em Am Dm F
 And the wild mountain thyme Grows a-round the bloomin' heather
C F C
 Will ye go, lassie, go?

Chorus:

F G C
 And we'll all go to-gether
F Em Am
 To pull wild mountain thyme
Dm F
 All a-round the bloomin' heather
C F C
 Will ye go, lassie, go?

*Starting note: ^ (C)



(C) F C F C
V.2: I will build my love a bower, By yon cool crystal fountain
F Em Am Dm F
 And round it I will pile All the wild flowers o' the mountain
C F C
 Will ye go, lassie, go?

(C) F C F C
V.3: I will range through the wilds, And the deep glen sae dreary
F Em Am Dm F
 And re-turn wi' their spoils To the bower o' my dearie
C F C
 Will ye go lassie go?

Chorus.....

(C) F C
V.4: If my true love she'll not come
F C
 Then I'll surely find a-nother
F Em Am
 To pull wild mountain thyme
Dm F
 All a-round the bloomin' heather
C F C
 Will ye go lassie go?

Chorus.....; repeat Chorus.....

Timing- 4/4:

ONE 2 3 4, ONE 2 3 4, ...

e.g. pluck strings in 'upwards ripple pattern':

B 3 2 1, B 3 2 1, ...

(B= bass string – heavier line in chord diagram)

Note: When playing more than one bar (pattern) in the same chord, you can alternate the B string and 4th string, i.e.:

B 3 2 1, 4 3 2 1, etc
